Greetings Supporters and Prayer Partners,

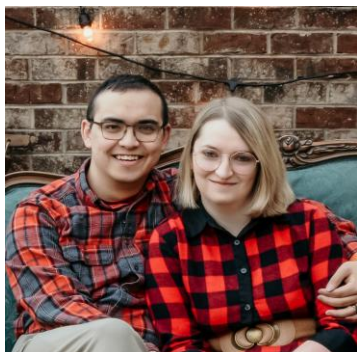
Thank you all for your tender prayers. We would like to praise the Lord for the meetings that we have had this final quarter of 2025.
